## Senate Bill 530

Sponsored by Senator KNOPP; Senator OLSEN (Presession filed.)

## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced.** 

Requires that collective bargaining agreements with state agency within executive branch be negotiated and entered into in even-numbered year preceding biennium in which agreement takes effect.

1	A BILL FOR AN ACT
2	Relating to collective bargaining agreements with executive branch.
3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 243.650 to
5	243.782.
6	SECTION 2. A collective bargaining agreement entered into under ORS 243.650 to 243.782
7	between a state agency within the executive branch of government and a labor organization
8	shall:
9	(1) Be negotiated and entered into no later than October 1 of the even-numbered year
10	immediately preceding the biennium in which the agreement takes effect;
11	(2) Take effect on July 1 of the year immediately following the date on which the agree-
12	ment was entered into; and
13	(3) Remain in effect for a period no longer than two years, but may be renewed.
14	SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2019 Act applies to collective bargaining agreements entered
15	into on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.
