## **SUMMARY**

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by State Marine Board. Limits biennial expenditures by board from federal funds.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the financial administration of the State Marine Board; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Marine Board, for the following purposes:

- Administration and education... \$ 7,277,632 **(1)**
- Marine law enforcement....... \$ 10,839,113 10
- **(3)** Facilities construction and 11
- maintenance...... \$ 8,563,458 12
- Aquatic invasive species .......... \$ 1,648,568 13

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Marine Board, for the following purposes:

- Administration and education... \$ 18
  - 233,760 Marine law enforcement...... \$ 4,035,575
- Facilities construction and 20
- maintenance..... \$ 1,990,930 21
- 60,000 22 Aquatic invasive species ...... \$

SECTION 3. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.
