Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. There are appropriated to the Department of State Police, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the following amounts, for the following purposes:

(1) Patrol services, criminal investigations, gaming enforcement and office of the State Fire Marshal ...... \$177,511,323

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the following amounts are established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limits for payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the Department of State Police, for the following purposes:

- (1) Patrol services, criminal investigations, gaming enforcement and office of the State Fire Marshal ...... \$105,696,397
- (2) Fish and wildlife enforcement...... \$ 30,833,219
- (3) Forensic services and Chief Medical Examiner...... \$ 934,343

SECTION 5. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.
