CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the authorized appropriations and expenditure limitations for the biennium ending June 30, 2019, for the Oregon Health Authority are changed by the amounts specified:
