SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

[Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by ____.]
[Limits biennial expenditures of ____ from federal funds.]

Appropriates moneys from General Fund to State Department of Energy for certain biennial expenses.

Limits biennial expenditures from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by department.

Limits certain biennial expenditures by department from lottery moneys.

Limits biennial expenditures by department from federal funds.

Authorizes specified nonlimited expenditures.

Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2019.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state financial administration; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. There is appropriated to the State Department of Energy, for the biennium**
5 **beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of \$4,334,048 for debt service for**
6 **the small scale local energy loan program.**

7 **SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
8 **\$31,236,157 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for**
9 **payment of expenses from fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts,**
10 **but excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the State Department**
11 **of Energy.**

12 **SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
13 **\$3,023,370 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for**
14 **payment of expenses from lottery moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Eco-**
15 **nomic Development Fund to the State Department of Energy for debt service for the energy**
16 **efficiency and sustainable technology loan program and for the Public Schools Grant Pro-**
17 **gram.**

18 **SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the amount of**
19 **\$2,203,426 is established for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for**
20 **payment of expenses from federal funds collected or received by the State Department of**

1 **Energy.**

2 **SECTION 5. For the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, the following expenditures by the**
3 **State Department of Energy are not limited:**

4 (1) Expenditures for loans for small scale local energy projects; and

5 (2) Expenditures for debt service.

6 **SECTION 6. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**
7 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect**
8 **July 1, 2019.**

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
