

# Senate Bill 577

Sponsored by Senators FREDERICK, PROZANSKI, Representative POWER, Senator MANNING JR; Representative WILLIAMSON (at the request of Attorney General Ellen Rosenblum) (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Justice to study topics relating to bias crimes and report results to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to judiciary on or before September 15, 2020.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to bias crimes.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Department of Justice shall study the enforcement of laws relating to**  
5 **bias crimes and methods of collecting data on the commission of bias crimes within this**  
6 **state. The department shall submit a report detailing the results of the study to the interim**  
7 **committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary in the manner provided by**  
8 **ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2020.**
