

Senate Bill 961

Sponsored by Senator ROBLAN (at the request of Steve Neville)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to amend statewide land use planning goals related to beaches and dunes to expand definition of "development."

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to statewide land use planning goal 18.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1.** (1) **The Legislative Assembly finds that, with respect to the statewide land**
5 **use planning goals related to beaches and dunes adopted by the Land Conservation and De-**
6 **velopment Commission, the definition of "development" should be expanded to include cer-**
7 **tain lands that have not been subdivided and lands upon which land use approval for**
8 **residential, commercial or industrial development was issued prior to January 1, 1977.**

9 (2) **The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall amend its statewide land**
10 **use planning goals related to beaches and dunes, consistent with subsection (1) of this sec-**
11 **tion.**
