Senate Bill 961

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Land Conservation and Development Commission to amend statewide land use planning goals related to beaches and dunes to expand definition of "development."

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to statewide land use planning goal 18.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Legislative Assembly finds that, with respect to the statewide land 5 use planning goals related to beaches and dunes adopted by the Land Conservation and De-6 velopment Commission, the definition of "development" should be expanded to include cer-7 tain lands that have not been subdivided and lands upon which land use approval for 8 residential, commercial or industrial development was issued prior to January 1, 1977.

9 (2) The Land Conservation and Development Commission shall amend its statewide land 10 use planning goals related to beaches and dunes, consistent with subsection (1) of this sec-11 tion.
