SENATE AMENDMENTS TO SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 18

Delete lines 8 through 11 of the printed joint resolution and insert:
"(2) The Legislative Assembly, the governing body of a city, county, municipality or district
empowered by law or by this Constitution to enact legislation, or the people through the initiative
process, may enact laws or ordinances regulating within its jurisdiction the use of moneys in poli-
tical campaigns, including:
"(a) Limiting contributions made in connection with political campaigns or to influence the
outcome of any election;
"(b) Requiring the disclosure of contributions or expenditures made in connection with political
campaigns or to influence the outcome of any election;
"(c) Requiring that an advertisement made in connection with a political campaign or to influ-
ence the outcome of any election identify the persons or entities who paid for the advertisement;
and
"(d) Any other regulation on the use of moneys in political campaigns permitted under the
Constitution of the United States.
"(3) Subsection (2) of this section applies to laws and ordinances enacted by the Legislative
Assembly or the governing body of a city, county, municipality or district, or enacted or approved
by the people through the initiative process, on or after January 1, 2016.".
