**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2883**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Recycling, Recovery and**
4 **Composting of Food Service Materials is established.**

5 **“(2) The task force consists of nine members appointed by the**
6 **Governor as follows:**

7 **“(a) Two members shall be persons who actively participate in re-**
8 **cycling polystyrene; and**

9 **“(b) Seven members shall be persons who are knowledgeable about**
10 **recycling, recovery and composting.**

11 **“(3) The task force shall review and assess technologies available**
12 **in recycling, recovery and composting of food service materials in or-**
13 **der to determine policy to increase recycling, recovery and composting**
14 **of food service materials as an alternative to a prohibition on**
15 **polystyrene containers for prepared food.**

16 **“(4) The task force may make recommendations based on the re-**
17 **view and assessment under subsection (3) of this section.**

18 **“(5) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a**
19 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

20 **“(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**
21 **majority of the members of the task force.**

1 “(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as
2 chairperson.

3 “(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make
4 an appointment to become immediately effective.

5 “(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the
6 call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the task
7 force.

8 “(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation
9 of the task force.

10 “(11) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided
11 in ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to
12 an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the en-
13 vironment no later than December 31, 2020.

14 “(12) The Department of Environmental Quality shall provide staff
15 support to the task force.

16 “(13) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation
17 or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task
18 force.

19 “(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,
20 are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the duties
21 of the task force and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to
22 confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the
23 task force consider necessary to perform their duties.

24 “SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on December 31,
25 2020.

26 “SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
27 date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
28 Assembly adjourns sine die.”.

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
