PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 423

- In line 4 of the printed bill, after "section" delete the rest of the line and delete line 5 and insert ":
- "(a) 'Law enforcement agency' means a public body, as defined in ORS 174.109, that employs law enforcement officers to enforce criminal laws.
- 5 "(b) 'Law enforcement officer' means a police officer, reserve officer or 6 certified reserve officer, as those terms are defined in ORS 181A.355.".
- In line 10, delete the period and delete lines 11 through 13 and insert who meets the qualifications and training requirements established by the Board on Public Safety Standards and Training by rule.
- "(4) The board shall establish by rule:
- "(a) The qualifications and training necessary for a licensed mental health professional to conduct a psychological screening under this section; and
- 14 "(b) Standards and procedures for conducting a psychological screening 15 under this section.
- "SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.
- "(2) Section 1 of this 2019 Act applies to persons hired by a law enforcement agency, including persons moving from one law enforcement agency to another law enforcement agency, on or after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section."
