PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3063

- On page 4 of the printed bill, delete lines 30 through 41 and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 5. (1) As used in this section:
- 3 "(a) 'Health care practitioner' means a person authorized to prac-

- "(c) 'Restrictable disease' means a disease defined as restrictable by the Oregon Health Authority pursuant to rules adopted under ORS

- "(2) A health care practitioner who has direct contact with patients shall, as a condition of the health care practitioner's authorization to
- 16 practice, submit to the health professional regulatory board that
- oversees the profession in which the health care practitioner is au-
- 18 thorized a record that indicates the health care practitioner has re-
- 19 ceived immunizations against restrictable diseases.
- "(3)(a) A health professional regulatory board shall adopt rules to
- 21 carry out this section, including rules to prevent a health care prac-

- 1 titioner who is not in compliance with subsection (2) of this section
- 2 from engaging in the practice in which the health care practitioner is
- 3 otherwise authorized.

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- "(b) A health professional regulatory board may consult with the authority for the purpose of adopting rules under this section.
- "SECTION 6. Section 5 of this 2019 Act applies to initial authori-
- 7 zations and renewals of authorizations issued on and after the opera-
- 8 tive date specified in section 9 of this 2019 Act.
- 9 "SECTION 7. Section 8 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 433.235 to 433.284.
- "SECTION 8. The Oregon Health Authority shall establish an outreach and education plan related to the implementation of ORS 433.235 to 433.284.
 - "SECTION 9. (1) Sections 5 and 8 of this 2019 Act become operative on January 1, 2020.
 - "(2) A health professional regulatory board and the Oregon Health Authority may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board and the authority to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the board and the authority by sections 5 and 8 of this 2019 Act.
 - "SECTION 10. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage."

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
