**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 320**

1 Delete lines 5 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 187.110 is amended to read:

3 **“187.110. (1)** The standard of time for the State of Oregon shall be **one**  
4 **hour in advance of** the United States standard of time as established by the  
5 Congress of the United States for any particular area of the state under 15  
6 U.S.C. 261, except that: *[from 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until*  
7 *2 a.m. on the first Sunday in November the standard of time for any area of*  
8 *this state shall be one hour in advance of the standard established for that*  
9 *particular area by the Congress of the United States under 15 U.S.C. 261.]*

10 **“(a) The standard of time for that portion of the State of Oregon**  
11 **that is in the Mountain Time Zone shall be the United States standard**  
12 **of time as established by the Congress of the United States for that**  
13 **area under 15 U.S.C. 261; and**

14 **“(b) From 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until 2 a.m. on**  
15 **the first Sunday in November the standard of time for that portion**  
16 **of the State of Oregon that is in the Mountain Time Zone shall be one**  
17 **hour in advance of the standard established for that area by the Con-**  
18 **gress of the United States under 15 U.S.C. 261.**

19 **“(2)** No department of the state government and no county, city or other  
20 political subdivision shall employ any other time or adopt any statute, ordi-  
21 nance or order providing for the use of any other standard of time.

1       **“SECTION 2. The amendments to ORS 187.110 by section 1 of this**  
2 **2019 Act become operative at 2 a.m. on the first Sunday of the first**  
3 **November in which the standard of time in the States of California**  
4 **and Washington is one hour in advance of the United States standard**  
5 **of time for California and Washington.**

6       **“SECTION 3. If the amendments to ORS 187.110 by section 1 of this**  
7 **2019 Act have not become operative by December 1, 2029, section 2 of**  
8 **this 2019 Act is repealed on December 1, 2029.**

9       **“SECTION 4. If section 2 of this 2019 Act is repealed by section 3 of this**  
10 **2019 Act, on December 1, 2029, ORS 187.110, as amended by section 1 of this**  
11 **2019 Act, is amended to read:**

12       **“187.110. (1) The standard of time for the State of Oregon shall be one**  
13 **hour in advance of the United States standard of time as established by the**  
14 **Congress of the United States for any particular area of the state under 15**  
15 **U.S.C. 261, except that[:]** **from 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March**  
16 **until 2 a.m. on the first Sunday in November the standard of time for**  
17 **any area of this state shall be one hour in advance of the standard**  
18 **established for that particular area by the Congress of the United**  
19 **States under 15 U.S.C. 261.**

20       ***“(a) The standard of time for that portion of the State of Oregon that is***  
21 ***in the Mountain Time Zone shall be the United States standard of time as***  
22 ***established by the Congress of the United States for that area; and]***

23       ***“(b) From 2 a.m. on the second Sunday in March until 2 a.m. on the first***  
24 ***Sunday in November the standard of time for that portion of the State of***  
25 ***Oregon that is in the Mountain Time Zone shall be one hour in advance of the***  
26 ***standard established for that particular area by the Congress of the United***  
27 ***States under 15 U.S.C. 261.]***

28       **“(2) No department of the state government and no county, city or other**  
29 **political subdivision shall employ any other time or adopt any statute, ordi-**  
30 **nance or order providing for the use of any other standard of time.”.**

1 In line 17, delete “3” and insert “5”.
