PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 491

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 10, delete "(1) and (2)" and after the
- 2 period insert "The foundation shall be advised by and shall consult with the
- advisory committee appointed under section 2 of this 2019 Act regarding any
- 4 expenditures made from the moneys transferred to the foundation under this
- 5 section.".
- 6 In line 14, delete "(1) or (2)".
- 7 Delete lines 18 through 28.
- 8 On page 2, delete lines 1 through 19 and insert:
- 9 "SECTION 2. The Oregon Council on Developmental Disabilities
- shall appoint an advisory committee to advise and consult with the
- 11 Oregon Community Foundation in making expenditures under section
- 12 1 of this 2019 Act. The committee must include one individual each to
- 13 represent:

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- "(1) Support services brokerages;
- "(2) Community developmental disability programs;
- "(3) Oregon coalitions consisting of individuals with intellectual or
- 17 developmental disabilities who encourage and facilitate self-advocacy
- by individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities;
- 19 "(4) Families of individuals with intellectual or developmental dis-
- 20 abilities;
 - "(5) The Housing and Community Services Department;

- "(6) Community-based residential providers of services to individ-
- 2 uals with intellectual or developmental disabilities; and
- 3 "(7) The system described in ORS 192.517 (1).
- **"SECTION 3.** ORS 427.340 is amended to read:
- 5 "427.340. (1) There is established a Developmental Disabilities Community
- 6 Housing Fund in the State Treasury, separate and distinct from the General
- 7 Fund. All moneys in the Developmental Disabilities Community Housing
- 8 Fund are continuously appropriated to the Department of Human Services
- 9 to pay expenses incurred by the Department of Human Services in carrying
- out the provisions of ORS 427.330 and 427.335. Interest earned on moneys in
- the fund shall be credited to the fund.
- "[(2) There is established within the fund a Community Housing Trust
- 13 Account. Notwithstanding the provisions of ORS 270.150, the Department of
- 14 Human Services shall negotiate with the Oregon Department of Administrative
- 15 Services to apply the proceeds from the sale, transfer or lease of any surplus
- 16 real property owned, operated or controlled by the Department of Human Ser-
- 17 vices and used as a state training center to the account. The Department of
- 18 Human Services may expend, for the purposes of ORS 427.330 to 427.345, any
- 19 earnings credited to the account, including any income from the lease of sur-
- 20 plus property and any interest earned on moneys deposited in the account, and
- 21 up to five percent of any sale or transfer proceeds initially credited to the ac-
- 22 count by the Oregon Department of Administrative Services. At least 95 per-
- 23 cent of all sale or transfer proceeds shall remain in the account in
- 24 perpetuity.]
- "[(3)] (2) The fund shall consist of:
- 26 "(a) Moneys appropriated to the fund by the Legislative Assembly;
- "(b) Repayment of financial assistance provided to housing providers or care providers for community housing under ORS 427.335 (3);
- 28 care providers for community housing under Otto 421.900 (9),
- "[(c) Proceeds from the account under subsection (2) of this section;]
- "[(d)] (c) Moneys reallocated from other areas of the Department of Hu-

- 1 man Services' budget; and
- 2 "[(e)] (d) Any earnings or interest credited to the fund.
- 3 "[(4) Moneys in the Community Housing Trust Account may, with the ap-
- 4 proval of the State Treasurer, be invested as provided under ORS 293.701 to
- 5 293.857, and the earnings from such investments must be credited to the Com-
- 6 munity Housing Trust Account.]
- 7 "[(5) The Department of Human Services shall provide a report of revenues
- 8 to and expenditures from the fund as part of its budget submission to the
- 9 Governor and Legislative Assembly under ORS chapter 291.]".
