to 14 of this 2019 Act become operative on January 1, 2020.

"(2) The amendments to ORS 830.990 by section 11 of this 2019 Act
become operative on August 1, 2020.

"(3) The State Marine Board may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the board to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all the duties, functions and powers conferred on the board by sections 2 to 9 of this 2019 Act and the amendments to ORS 830.110, 830.565, 830.570 and 830.575 by sections 10 and 12 to 14 of this 2019 Act.".
