PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2916

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete "446.003,".
- Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 4.
- On page 5, delete lines 1 through 31 and insert:
- 4 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 446.265 is amended to read:
- 5 "446.265. (1) A [municipality] local government may [approve] authorize
- 6 the establishment of a campground inside an urban growth boundary [to be
- 7 used for [providing] transitional housing accommodations. The accommo-
- 8 dations may consist of separate facilities, in the form of yurts, for use] used
- 9 as living units by one or more individuals [or by families. The person estab-
- lishing the accommodations may provide access to water, toilet, shower, laun-
- 11 dry, cooking, telephone or other services either through separate or shared
- 12 facilities. The accommodations shall provide parking facilities and
- 13 walkways].
- "[(2)] **Use of** transitional housing accommodations [described under sub-
- section (1) of this section shall be] is limited to persons who lack permanent
- or safe shelter and who cannot be placed in other low income housing. A
- 17 [municipality] local government may limit the maximum amount of time
- that an individual or a family may use the accommodations.
- "[(3)] (2) [Campgrounds providing transitional housing accommodations
- 20 described under this section may be operated by private persons or nonprofit
- 21 organizations.] Transitional housing accommodations are intended to

- be used by individuals or families on a limited basis for seasonal,
- 2 emergency or transitional housing purposes and may include yurts,
- 3 huts, cabins, fabric structures, tents and similar accommodations. The
- 4 transitional housing accommodations may provide parking facilities,
- 5 walkways and access to water, toilet, shower, laundry, cooking, tele-
- 6 phone or other services either through separate or shared facilities.
- 7 The Oregon Health Authority may regulate the shared facilities of the
- 8 campgrounds [are subject to regulation under the recreation park specialty
- 9 code described under ORS 446.310 to 446.350].
- "(3) [The] Transitional housing accommodations are not subject to ORS chapter 90.
- "[(4) To the extent deemed relevant by The Department of Consumer and
- 13 Business Services, the construction and installation of yurts on campgrounds
- 14 used for providing transitional housing accommodations established under this
- 15 section is subject to the manufactured structures specialty code described in
- 16 ORS 446.155. Transitional housing accommodations not appurtenant to a yurt
- are subject to regulation as provided under subsection (3) of this section.
- "[(5) Campgrounds established for providing transitional housing accom-
- 19 modations shall not be allowed on more than two parcels in a municipality.
- 20 In approving the use of parcels for a campground, the municipality shall give
- 21 preference to locations that have access to grocery stores and public transit
- 22 services.

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- "[(6)] (4) As used in this section, 'yurt' means a round, domed tent of
- 24 canvas or other weather resistant material, having a rigid framework,
- 25 wooden floor, one or more windows or skylights and that may have plumbing,
- 26 electrical service or heat.
 - **"SECTION 2.** ORS 446.325 is amended to read:
- ²⁸ "446.325. (1) [Public entities, private persons or nonprofit organizations
- 29 described] A person operating a campground for transitional housing
- accommodations under ORS 446.265 [(3)], timber companies and private

- 1 utilities [shall] may not establish or operate a recreation park without
- 2 complying with the rules of the Oregon Health Authority and securing the
- 3 approval of the Director of the Oregon Health Authority or designee but
- 4 [shall be] are exempt from the licensing requirement of ORS 446.320. The
- 5 director or designee may delegate, to a health official having sufficient en-
- 6 vironmental health specialists, the authority to approve such recreation
- 7 parks.
- 8 "(2) ORS 446.310 to 446.350 do not apply to:
- 9 "(a) Any structure designed for and occupied as a single family residence
- in which no more than two sleeping rooms are provided on a daily or weekly
 - basis for the use of no more than a total of six travelers or transients at any
- one time for a charge or fee paid or to be paid for the rental or use of the
- 13 facilities;
- "(b) Any temporary camping sites used solely and incidentally in the
- course of backpacking, hiking, horseback packing, canoeing, rafting or other
- 16 expedition, unless the expedition is part of an organizational camp program;
- 17 or

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- "(c) [A yurt, as defined in ORS 446.265, that is used as a living unit in
- 19 transitional housing accommodations] Transitional housing accommo-
- 20 dations.".
