**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 140**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 16, insert:

2 “(3) Grants awarded under subsection (2) of this section must include at  
3 least one grant to a hospital located in a rural or frontier area, as defined  
4 by the Office of Rural Health.”.

5 In line 18, delete “13” and insert “20”.

6 In line 26, delete “One member” and insert “Two members” and after  
7 “Services” insert “, one of whom works in the division of the department that  
8 serves older adults and persons with disabilities and one of whom works in  
9 the division of the department that provides child welfare services”.

10 On page 2, delete line 1 and insert:

11 “(H) One member who is an emergency room physician;

12 “(I) One member who is a psychiatrist;

13 “(J) One member who is a psychiatric nurse practitioner;

14 “(K) One member representing a substance use disorder treatment center;

15 “(L) One member from the Department of Veterans’ Affairs;

16 “(M) One member who is a direct care provider of mental health treat-  
17 ment who is not a manager where the member is employed;

18 “(N) One member representing a community mental health center;

19 “(O) One member representing a federally qualified health center; and”.

20 In line 2, delete “(I)” and insert “(P)”.

21 In line 5, after “shall” delete the rest of the line and insert “identify the

1 root causes of”.

2 In line 7, delete the period and insert “and propose solutions, including  
3 but not limited to:

4 “(a) Statutory changes;

5 “(b) State funding; and

6 “(c) Workforce development.”.

7 In line 37, after “of” delete the rest of the line and delete line 38 and  
8 insert “\$3,500,000, of which:

9 “(1) \$3,250,000 shall be expended for administering and providing grants  
10 in the Emergency Department Boarding Pilot Project established in section  
11 1 of this 2019 Act; and

12 “(2) \$250,000 may be expended for the Task Force on Emergency Depart-  
13 ment Boarding established in section 2 of this 2019 Act.”.
