## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO

HOUSE BILL 2804

On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page $\underline{2}$ and insert:
"SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
"(a) 'Animal shelter' means an organization or facility, in this or another state, that:
"(A) Is maintained by or under contract with a state, county or city or is tax exempt under section $501(\mathrm{c})(3)$ of the Internal Revenue Code; and
"(B) Is operated for the primary purpose of:
"(i) Providing shelter and other care for lost, homeless or injured animals; or
"(ii) Placing animals into permanent homes or with rescue organizations.
"(b) 'Cat' means a member of the species Felis catus.
"(c) 'Dog' means a member of the subspecies Canis lupus familiaris or a hybrid of that subspecies.
"(d) 'Domestic animal' has the meaning given that term in ORS 167.310.
"(e) 'Rescue organization' means a nonprofit corporation that:
"(A) Provides rescue services for animals including, at a minimum, dogs or cats;
"(B) Is tax exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code; and
"(C) Does not obtain dogs or cats from a breeder or broker for payment or other compensation.
"(f) 'Retail pet store':
"(A) Means a retail establishment open to the public that sells or offers to sell domestic animals.
"(B) Does not include a person that sells or offers to sell only domestic animals that the person breeds or raises.
"(2) A retail pet store may not sell or offer to sell a dog or cat.
"(3) The sale or offering for sale of a dog or cat at a retail pet store as part of an adoption event held by an animal shelter or rescue organization is not a sale or offer to sell by the retail pet store for purposes of subsection (2) of this section if the retail pet store does not receive any payment from the sale or offering or for the use of the store or store resources in connection with the adoption event.
"(4) A sale or offer for sale of a dog or cat in violation of this section is a Class A violation. For purposes of this subsection, each event or transaction in which a dog or cat is sold or offered for sale in violation of this section constitutes a separate offense.
"(5) Subsections (1) to (4) of this section do not prohibit a city or county from adopting provisions of law that are more protective of animal welfare.
"SECTION 2. ORS 646A. 075 is repealed.
"SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2019 Act applies to retail pet store sales or offers to sell made on or after the effective date of this 2019 Act.".
