**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 29**

1 Delete line 2 of the printed concurrent resolution and insert:

2 “Whereas Sheriff Glenn A. Shipman was born on April 3, 1927, in
3 Vernonia, Oregon, to Eugene and Hazel Shipman; and

4 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman enlisted in the United States Navy on April
5 17, 1944, just after his 17th birthday; and

6 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman served in the Pacific Theater during World
7 War II aboard the USS *Ajax*, which survived Japanese kamikaze air attacks
8 and two typhoons; and

9 “Whereas following his active-duty Navy service, Sheriff Shipman served
10 many years in the Naval Reserve; and

11 “Whereas following the war, Sheriff Shipman worked in a sawmill and
12 then decided to make law enforcement his career; and

13 “Whereas in 1948, Sheriff Shipman joined the Oregon State Police (OSP),
14 where he served as a trooper with honor and distinction for 16 years; and

15 “Whereas while serving with the OSP in St. Helens, Oregon, Sheriff
16 Shipman met the love of his life, Joanne Murgic, and they married and raised
17 a family together; and

18 “Whereas in 1964, Sheriff Shipman began his long and distinguished ca-
19 reer with the Yamhill County Sheriff’s Office, where he rose steadily through
20 the ranks; and

21 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman was appointed Yamhill County Sheriff in 1980,

1 and he was subsequently elected to two full terms as sheriff; and

2 “Whereas during Sheriff Shipman’s tenure, Yamhill County extended its
3 law enforcement coverage to some of the county’s smaller cities, added ad-
4 ditional deputies and expanded its jail facility; and

5 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman’s innovative vision and leadership enhanced
6 the efficiency and quality of law enforcement in Yamhill County, greatly
7 improving the safety of the community; and

8 “Whereas in 1986, Sheriff Shipman was named Sheriff of the Year by the
9 Oregon State Sheriffs’ Association, and he also served as president of the
10 association; and

11 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman was a graduate of the Federal Bureau of In-
12 vestigation National Academy; and

13 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman retired in 1989, but he continued to offer his
14 leadership and expertise to Yamhill County, serving on both the board of
15 equalization and the budget committee; and

16 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman cared deeply about his community, and he was
17 involved in numerous charitable and civic organizations, including local
18 chapters of the United Way, Lions Clubs International, Scottish Rite and
19 Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks; and

20 “Whereas Sheriff Shipman passed away on January 27, 2016; and

21 “Whereas in a remarkable law enforcement career that lasted more than
22 40 years, Sheriff Shipman served the people of Yamhill County and the State
23 of Oregon with consummate integrity, professionalism and dedication; now,
24 therefore.”.

25 Delete lines 4 and 5 and insert:

26 “That we, the members of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly, recognize
27 and honor Sheriff Glenn A. Shipman for his service to his nation, state and
28 community.”.
