**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 582**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 6 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 2. (1) The Governor may enter into an agreement with
4 another state for the purposes of:**

5 **“(a) Cross-jurisdictional coordination and enforcement of
6 marijuana-related businesses authorized to conduct business in either
7 this state or the other state; and**

8 **“(b) Cross-jurisdictional delivery of marijuana items between this
9 state and the other state.**

10 **“(2) An agreement entered into under this section:**

11 **“(a) Must ensure enforceable public health and safety standards,
12 and include a system to regulate and track the interstate delivery of
13 marijuana items;**

14 **“(b) Must ensure that any marijuana items delivered into this state,
15 prior to sale to a consumer, are:**

16 **“(A) Tested in accordance with ORS 475B.550 to 475B.590 and any
17 rules adopted pursuant to ORS 475B.550 to 475B.590; and**

18 **“(B) Packaged and labeled in accordance with ORS 475B.600 to
19 475B.655 and any rules adopted pursuant to ORS 475B.600 to 475B.655;
20 and**

21 **“(c) May authorize one or more agencies of this state to provide**

1 policy recommendations and assist in the implementation and
2 enforcement of the terms of the agreement.

3 “(3) Notwithstanding ORS 475B.227 and in accordance with an
4 agreement described in this section:

5 “(a) A marijuana producer, marijuana processor, marijuana whole-
6 saler or marijuana researcher certified under ORS 475B.286 may deliver
7 marijuana items to a person located in, and authorized to receive
8 marijuana items by, the other state.

9 “(b) A marijuana processor, marijuana wholesaler, marijuana
10 retailer or marijuana researcher certified under ORS 475B.286 may re-
11 ceive marijuana items from a person located in, and authorized to
12 export marijuana items by, the other state.

13 **“SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on the**
14 **earlier of the date on which:**

15 “(a) Federal law is amended to allow for the interstate transfer of
16 marijuana items between authorized marijuana-related businesses; or

17 “(b) The United States Department of Justice issues an opinion or
18 memorandum allowing or tolerating the interstate transfer of
19 marijuana items between authorized marijuana-related businesses.

20 “(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall notify the interim
21 committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary and
22 the Legislative Counsel upon the occurrence of an event described in
23 subsection (1) of this section.”.
