**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 455**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1.** ORS 352.629 is amended to read:

4 “352.629. (1) As used in this section:

5 “(a) ‘Apprentice’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 660.010.

6 “(b) ‘Apprenticeable occupation’ has the meaning given that term in ORS  
7 660.010.

8 “(c) ‘Apprenticeship training program’ means the total system of appren-  
9 ticeship that a particular local joint committee, as defined in ORS 660.010,  
10 operates, including the local joint committee’s registered standards and all  
11 other terms and conditions for qualifying, recruiting, selecting, employing  
12 and training apprentices in an apprenticeable occupation.

13 **“(d) ‘Community college’ means a community college as defined in**  
14 **ORS 341.005 or a community college district as defined in ORS 341.005.**

15 “[*d*] (e) ‘Minority individual’ has the meaning given that term in ORS  
16 200.005.

17 “[*e*] (f) ‘Qualified contracts’ means contracts that:

18 “(A) Are for improvements to real property [*in connection with the Uni-*  
19 *versity of Oregon Campus for Accelerating Scientific Impact*]; **and**

20 “(B) Have a cost that, at the time the contract is executed, is estimated  
21 to be greater than [*\$200,000; and*] **\$8 million.**

1        “[C] Are to be paid from proceeds of bonds issued under Article XI-G of  
2 the Oregon Constitution.]

3        “[f] (g) ‘Woman’ has the meaning given that term in ORS 200.005.

4        **“(2) A public university listed in ORS 352.002 or a community college  
5 may not award a qualified contract to a prospective contractor unless  
6 the prospective contractor is a training agent as defined in ORS  
7 660.010.**

8        “[2] (3) [*The University of Oregon*] **A public university listed in ORS  
9 352.002 or a community college**, in all qualified contracts, shall require  
10 contractors to:

11        “[a] *Employ apprentices to perform 15 percent of the work hours that  
12 workers in apprenticeable occupations perform under the contract, in a manner  
13 consistent with the apprentices’ respective apprenticeship training programs;*]

14        “[b] (a) Establish and execute a plan for outreach, recruitment and re-  
15 tention of women and minority individuals to perform work under the con-  
16 tract; and

17        “[c] (b) Require any subcontractors engaged by the contractors to abide  
18 by the requirements set forth in [*paragraphs (a) and (b)*] **paragraph (a)** of  
19 this subsection.

20        “[3] (4) On or before February 1 of each year, [*the University of  
21 Oregon*] **public universities and community colleges with ongoing  
22 qualified contracts** shall report to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means  
23 or Joint Interim Committee on Ways and Means on the amount of work  
24 performed by apprentices, women and minority individuals under qualified  
25 contracts.

26        **“SECTION 2. (1) The amendments to ORS 352.629 by section 1 of this  
27 2019 Act apply to contracts that a public university or community  
28 college first advertises or otherwise solicits on or after the effective  
29 date of this 2019 Act or, if the public university or community college  
30 does not advertise or solicit the contract, to contracts that the public**

1 **university or community college first enters into on or after the ef-**  
2 **fective date of this 2019 Act.**

3 **“(2) As used in this section, ‘community college’ has the meaning**  
4 **given that term in ORS 352.629.”.**
