PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2229

1 On <u>page 1</u> of the printed bill, line 2, after the first semicolon delete the 2 rest of the line and insert "and".

3 Delete lines 5 through 28 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 "<u>SECTION 1.</u> (1) The Department of Education shall establish and
 5 administer a pilot program to assist school districts in providing age 6 appropriate instruction on natural disasters.

7 "(2) Instruction provided under the pilot program established by
8 this section must:

9 "(a) Enable students to prepare for a natural disaster and survival
10 in the days and weeks after a natural disaster; and

"(b) Be specific to the natural disasters that may occur in the areas 11 served by the schools participating in the pilot program, and may in-12 clude earthquakes, tsunamis, water shortages, floods and heavy snow. 13 "(3) Any school district in this state may apply to participate in the 14 pilot program established by this section. The department shall select 15no more than five school districts to participate in the pilot program. 16 When selecting school districts to participate in the pilot program, the 17 department shall give priority to school districts that represent ge-18 ographic and demographic diversity. 19

20 "(4) For school districts participating in the pilot program estab-21 lished by this section, the department shall: "(a) Develop curriculum that may be used by the school districts;
and

"(b) Provide any necessary technical assistance to the school districts.

5 "(5) The department shall submit a report to the appropriate in-6 terim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to education no 7 later than:

8 "(a) September 15, 2022, for a preliminary report; and

9 "(b) September 15, 2024, for a final report.

"SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2,
2025.

"SECTION 3. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-12ation, there is appropriated to the Department of Education, for the 13 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount 14 of \$____, which may be expended for developing curriculum and 15providing technical assistance as described in section 1 of this 2019 Act. 16 "SECTION 4. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate 17 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is 18 declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect July 1, 2019.". 19 20
