

Requested by Senator BENTZ

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2020**

1 On page 14 of the printed bill, line 8, delete “either a sector benchmark”  
2 and insert “a national sector benchmark, an Oregon sector benchmark”.

3 In line 20, delete “a” and insert “an”.

4 In line 21, before “sector” insert “Oregon”.

5 After line 43, insert:

6 “(d) For a good manufactured in this state through an emissions-intensive,  
7 trade-exposed process by a covered entity or opt-in entity that uses recycled  
8 material for over 90 percent of its feedstock for the good, the office shall  
9 calculate a national sector benchmark for the good by:

10 “(A) Calculating the three-year average of the total, expressed in tons of  
11 carbon dioxide equivalent, of greenhouse gas emissions, attributable to  
12 manufacture of the good in the United States in each year using greenhouse  
13 gas emissions information reported under the United States Environmental  
14 Protection Agency Greenhouse Gas Reporting Program from the three most  
15 recent years prior to 2021 for which data is available; and

16 “(B) Dividing the number calculated under subparagraph (A) of this par-  
17 agraph by the three-year average of the total annual output of the good  
18 manufactured in the United States using information on the production  
19 quantities for such three most recent years prior to 2021 reported by the  
20 United States Geological Survey or similar publicly available resources.”.
