PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2395

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, after line 7, insert:

2 "(b) 'Consensus standard' means a standard that a standards development 3 organization with national or industry-wide recognition promulgates.".

4 In line 8, delete "(b)" and insert "(c)".

5 In line 10, delete "(2)" and insert "(2)(a)".

6 After line 15, insert:

"(b) For the purpose of paragraph (a) of this subsection, reasonable security features may consist of equipping a connected device with means to
protect from unauthorized access, destruction, modification, use or disclosure
that are consistent with a consensus standard if:

11 "(A) The consensus standard addresses commonly known or reasonably 12 foreseeable vulnerabilities in the connected device as of the date on which 13 the person manufactures the connected device; and

14 "(B) The person that manufactures the connected device ensures that the 15 connected device conforms with any amendments to the consensus standard 16 not later than one year after the effective date of the amendments.".
