**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2883**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 5 through 28 and delete page  
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Task Force on Recycling, Recovery and**  
4 **Composting of Food Service Materials is established.**

5 **“(2) The task force consists of nine members appointed by the**  
6 **Governor as follows:**

7 **“(a) Two members shall be persons who actively participate in re-**  
8 **cycling polystyrene; and**

9 **“(b) Seven members shall be persons who are knowledgeable about**  
10 **recycling, recovery and composting.**

11 **“(3) The task force shall review and assess technologies available**  
12 **in recycling, recovery and composting of food service materials in or-**  
13 **der to determine whether there are alternatives to prohibiting the use**  
14 **of polystyrene containers for prepared food.**

15 **“(4) The task force may make recommendations based on the re-**  
16 **view and assessment under subsection (3) of this section.**

17 **“(5) A majority of the members of the task force constitutes a**  
18 **quorum for the transaction of business.**

19 **“(6) Official action by the task force requires the approval of a**  
20 **majority of the members of the task force.**

21 **“(7) The task force shall elect one of its members to serve as**

1 **chairperson.**

2 **“(8) If there is a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall make**  
3 **an appointment to become immediately effective.**

4 **“(9) The task force shall meet at times and places specified by the**  
5 **call of the chairperson or of a majority of the members of the task**  
6 **force.**

7 **“(10) The task force may adopt rules necessary for the operation**  
8 **of the task force.**

9 **“(11) The task force shall submit a report in the manner provided**  
10 **in ORS 192.245, and may include recommendations for legislation, to**  
11 **an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to the en-**  
12 **vironment no later than December 31, 2020.**

13 **“(12) The Department of Environmental Quality shall provide staff**  
14 **support to the task force.**

15 **“(13) Members of the task force are not entitled to compensation**  
16 **or reimbursement for expenses and serve as volunteers on the task**  
17 **force.**

18 **“(14) All agencies of state government, as defined in ORS 174.111,**  
19 **are directed to assist the task force in the performance of the duties**  
20 **of the task force and, to the extent permitted by laws relating to**  
21 **confidentiality, to furnish information and advice the members of the**  
22 **task force consider necessary to perform their duties.**

23 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on December 31,**  
24 **2020.**

25 **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**  
26 **date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative**  
27 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
