## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2098

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "marijuana;" delete the rest of the line and delete line 3 and insert "and prescribing an effective date.".
- Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall es-
- 5 tablish an advisory committee to advise the commission, the Oregon
- 6 Health Authority and the State Department of Agriculture on estab-
- 7 lishing and maintaining standards for testing the potency of marijuana
- 8 and marijuana items, as those terms are defined in ORS 475B.015. The
- 9 members of the committee must include members who are:
- "(a) Representatives of the commission, the authority and the department;
  - "(b) Stakeholders in the marijuana industry; and

- 13 "(c) Individuals who have expertise in the potency testing of 14 marijuana and marijuana items.
- 15 "(2) The commission may adopt rules to carry out this section.
- "SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on January 1, 2020.
- "(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may take any action before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary to enable the commission to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the du-

ties, functions and powers conferred on the commission by section 1 of this 2019 Act.

"SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.".
