PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2969

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 30.
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 13 and insert:

- "(d) Is part of an academic research-based institution.
- "(2) The contract shall provide that the nonprofit organization shall

- 14 nation and collaboration with public bodies and private entities that
- serve children, adolescents and families, including but not limited to
- 16 persons who represent:
- "(a) The Department of Human Services.
- 18 "(b) The Oregon Youth Authority.
- 19 "(c) The Department of Education.
- 20 "(d) The Oregon Health Authority.
- 21 "(e) The Youth Development Council.

- 2 "(g) Nonprofit organizations.
- 3 "(h) County public health programs.
- 4 "(i) Juvenile crime prevention programs.
- 5 "(j) Early Learning Hubs.
- 6 "(k) School health providers.
- 7 "(L) State and local law enforcement agencies.
- 8 "(m) The Department of Corrections.
- 9 "(n) The Department of Justice.
- 10 "(o) The Oregon Criminal Justice Commission.
- "(p) District attorneys.
- 12 "(q) The Judicial Department.
- 13 "(3) The trauma-informed practice integration program shall:
- 14 "(a) Clearly define the characteristics of the target population of 15 children, adolescents and families to be served by the program.
- 16 "(b) Review trauma-informed practice integration programs in other states.
- 18 "(c) Define what it means to provide trauma-informed services.
- "(d) Develop a list of performance measures that measure the success of public bodies and private entities in providing trauma-informed services to the target population.
- 22 "(e) Identify trauma-informed policies and services underway across 23 this state.
- 24 "(f) Coordinate trauma-informed initiatives across state agencies.
- 25 "(g) Identify systemic barriers to and gaps in services.
- 26 "(h) Leverage existing trauma-informed resources and initiatives 27 to encourage consistency and eliminate duplication of resources.
- 28 "(i) Recommend changes to existing trauma-informed practices and policies.
- 30 "(4) The contract entered into under this section shall provide that

- the nonprofit organization shall submit an annual report to the Legislative Assembly and the Governor:
- 3 "(a) Detailing the progress made in carrying out the provisions of 4 this section; and
- 5 "(b) Containing specific recommendations for any additional legis-6 lation the organization deems necessary to carry out the purposes of 7 the trauma practice integration program.
- 8 "(5) As used in this section, 'public body' has the meaning given that term in ORS 174.109.".
