**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2098**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after “marijuana;” delete the rest of
2 the line and delete line 3 and insert “and prescribing an effective date.”.

3 Delete lines 5 through 30 and delete pages 2 through 5 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall es-**
5 **tablish an advisory committee to advise the commission, the Oregon**
6 **Health Authority and the State Department of Agriculture on estab-**
7 **lishing and maintaining standards for testing the potency of marijuana**
8 **and marijuana items, as those terms are defined in ORS 475B.015. The**
9 **members of the committee must include members who are:**

10 **“(a) Representatives of the commission, the authority and the de-**
11 **partment;**

12 **“(b) Stakeholders in the marijuana industry; and**

13 **“(c) Individuals who have expertise in the potency testing of**
14 **marijuana and marijuana items.**

15 **“(2) The commission may adopt rules to carry out this section.**

16 **“SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on**
17 **January 1, 2020.**

18 **“(2) The Oregon Liquor Control Commission may take any action**
19 **before the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that**
20 **is necessary to enable the commission to exercise, on and after the**
21 **operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the du-**

1 ties, functions and powers conferred on the commission by section 1
2 of this 2019 Act.

3 **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
4 **date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative**
5 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”**
