**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 855**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, delete “; and declaring an
2 emergency”.

3 Delete lines 4 through 30 and delete page 2 and insert:

4 **“SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 **“(a) ‘Occupational or professional service’ means a service:**

6 **“(A) That an individual must possess a license, certificate or other
7 form of authorization to provide under the laws of this state; and**

8 **“(B) Over which a professional licensing board has regulatory
9 oversight.**

10 **“(b) ‘Professional licensing board’ means a state agency or board
11 that licenses, certifies or otherwise authorizes individuals to provide
12 an occupational or professional service.**

13 **“(2) Each professional licensing board shall study the manner in
14 which persons who are noncitizens become licensed, certified or oth-
15 erwise authorized in the occupational or professional service regulated
16 by the professional licensing board. Each professional licensing board
17 shall develop a report that identifies methods to reduce barriers to
18 licensure, certification or other authorization for applicants who may
19 be noncitizens.**

20 **“(3) Each professional licensing board shall study the criminal
21 background criteria and character standards the board uses in ap-**

1 **proving applicants for licensure, certification or other authorization.**
2 **Each professional licensing board shall identify methods to reduce**
3 **barriers to licensure, certification or other authorization for appli-**
4 **cants who may not qualify for licensure, certification or other au-**
5 **thorization because of their criminal background or character.**

6 **“(4) Each professional licensing board shall develop and submit re-**
7 **ports on the studies described in subsections (2) and (3) of this section**
8 **in the manner provided by ORS 192.245 to an interim committee of the**
9 **Legislative Assembly related to the workforce not later than December**
10 **31, 2020.**

11 **“SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2019 Act is repealed on January 2,**
12 **2021.”.**
