PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 534

- In line 2 of the printed bill, before the period insert "; and prescribing an effective date".
- 3 Delete lines 4 through 12 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2019 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 197.
- "SECTION 2. Within the urban growth boundary of a city with a population greater than 25,000, local governments shall allow, subject to reasonable local regulations relating to siting and design, the development of at least one dwelling unit on each platted lot that is zoned to allow for single-family dwellings, unless the local government determines that:
- "(1) The lot is not adequately served by water, sewer or streets;
- "(2) The lot contains a slope of 25 percent or greater;
- 14 "(3) The lot is within a 100-year floodplain; or
- 15 "(4) Development of the lot is constrained by land use regulations 16 based on statewide land use planning goals relating to:
 - "(a) Natural disasters and hazards; or
- 18 "(b) Natural resources, including air, water, land, natural areas or 19 open spaces, but not including historic resources.
- "SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on June 30, 2022.".

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
