**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3001**

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. As used in this section and section 2 of this 2019 Act:**

3 **“(1) ‘Car rental company’ has the meaning given that term in ORS**
4 **803.219.**

5 **“(2) ‘Commercial airport authority’ means the Port of Portland or**
6 **a city or county that operates a commercial airport in this state.**

7 **“(3) ‘Peer-to-peer car rental’ means the use of a privately owned**
8 **motor vehicle by a person other than the registered owner of the mo-**
9 **tor vehicle in return for consideration pursuant to an agreement fa-**
10 **cilitated by a peer-to-peer car rental program.**

11 **“(4) ‘Peer-to-peer car rental facilitator’ means a person that en-**
12 **gages in the business of operating or administering a peer-to-peer car**
13 **rental program.**

14 **“(5) ‘Peer-to-peer car rental program’ means a business in which a**
15 **peer-to-peer car rental facilitator facilitates peer-to-peer car rentals.**

16 **“SECTION 2. (1)(a) All airport fees and state and local laws appli-**
17 **cable to car rental companies, including laws that impose taxes and**
18 **fees, shall apply on the same terms to peer-to-peer car rental pro-**
19 **grams.**

20 **“(b) Only the state government and the governing bodies of the**
21 **Port of Portland and of ports formed pursuant to ORS chapter 777 may**

1 **impose taxes and fees that apply solely to peer-to-peer car rental pro-**
2 **grams and not to car rental companies on the same terms.**

3 **“(2)(a) A commercial airport authority may require a peer-to-peer**
4 **car rental program to enter into an agreement with the commercial**
5 **airport authority as a condition of allowing the peer-to-peer car rental**
6 **program to operate within the jurisdiction of the commercial airport**
7 **authority or on the premises of the commercial airport operated by the**
8 **commercial airport authority.**

9 **“(b) An agreement entered into pursuant to this subsection may**
10 **include, with respect to the operation of the peer-to-peer car rental**
11 **program within the jurisdiction of the commercial airport authority**
12 **or on the premises of the commercial airport operated by the com-**
13 **mmercial airport authority:**

14 **“(A) Provisions that require the peer-to-peer car rental program to**
15 **pay fees to the commercial airport authority or obtain insurance cov-**
16 **erage;**

17 **“(B) Provisions that designate drop-off and pick-up locations or**
18 **other areas of operation; and**

19 **“(C) Any other provisions that the commercial airport authority**
20 **considers necessary or convenient.**

21 **“SECTION 3. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
22 **date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative**
23 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**

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
