PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 3001

1 Delete lines 4 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> As used in this section and section 2 of this 2019 Act:
 "(1) 'Car rental company' has the meaning given that term in ORS

4 **803.219.**

"(2) 'Commercial airport authority' means the Port of Portland or
a city or county that operates a commercial airport in this state.

"(3) 'Peer-to-peer car rental' means the use of a privately owned
motor vehicle by a person other than the registered owner of the motor vehicle in return for consideration pursuant to an agreement facilitated by a peer-to-peer car rental program.

"(4) 'Peer-to-peer car rental facilitator' means a person that en gages in the business of operating or administering a peer-to-peer car
 rental program.

"(5) 'Peer-to-peer car rental program' means a business in which a
 peer-to-peer car rental facilitator facilitates peer-to-peer car rentals.

16 "<u>SECTION 2.</u> (1)(a) All airport fees and state and local laws appli-17 cable to car rental companies, including laws that impose taxes and 18 fees, shall apply on the same terms to peer-to-peer car rental pro-19 grams.

"(b) Only the state government and the governing bodies of the
 Port of Portland and of ports formed pursuant to ORS chapter 777 may

impose taxes and fees that apply solely to peer-to-peer car rental programs and not to car rental companies on the same terms.

"(2)(a) A commercial airport authority may require a peer-to-peer car rental program to enter into an agreement with the commercial airport authority as a condition of allowing the peer-to-peer car rental program to operate within the jurisdiction of the commercial airport authority or on the premises of the commercial airport operated by the commercial airport authority.

9 "(b) An agreement entered into pursuant to this subsection may 10 include, with respect to the operation of the peer-to-peer car rental 11 program within the jurisdiction of the commercial airport authority 12 or on the premises of the commercial airport operated by the com-13 mercial airport authority:

"(A) Provisions that require the peer-to-peer car rental program to
 pay fees to the commercial airport authority or obtain insurance cov erage;

"(B) Provisions that designate drop-off and pick-up locations or
 other areas of operation; and

"(C) Any other provisions that the commercial airport authority
 considers necessary or convenient.

"<u>SECTION 3.</u> This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative
Assembly adjourns sine die.".

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
