PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 1013

- On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 28
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 20 and insert:
- "SECTION 1. ORS 163.095 is amended to read:
- 4 "163.095. As used in ORS 163.105 and this section, 'aggravated murder'
- 5 means [murder as defined in ORS 163.115 which]:
- "(1) Criminal homicide of two or more persons that is premeditated
- and committed intentionally [under, or accompanied by, any of the following
- 8 circumstances and with the intent to:
- 9 "(a) Intimidate, injure or coerce a civilian population;
- 10 "(b) Influence the policy of a government by intimidation or 11 coercion; or
- 12 "(c) Affect the conduct of a government through destruction of 13 property, murder, kidnapping or aircraft piracy; or
- "(2) Murder in the second degree, as defined in ORS 163.115, that is premeditated and committed intentionally against a person under 14 years of age.
- "[(1)(a) The defendant committed the murder pursuant to an agreement that
 the defendant receive money or other thing of value for committing the
 murder.]
- "[(b) The defendant solicited another to commit the murder and paid or agreed to pay the person money or other thing of value for committing the

- 1 *murder*.]
- "[(c) The defendant committed murder after having been convicted previ-
- 3 ously in any jurisdiction of any homicide, the elements of which constitute the
- 4 crime of murder as defined in ORS 163.115 or manslaughter in the first degree
- 5 *as defined in ORS 163.118.*]
- 6 "[(d) There was more than one murder victim in the same criminal episode
- 7 as defined in ORS 131.505.]
- 8 "[(e) The homicide occurred in the course of or as a result of intentional
- 9 maining or torture of the victim.]
- "[(f) The victim of the intentional homicide was a person under the age of
- 11 *14 years.*]
- "[(2)(a) The victim was one of the following and the murder was related to
- 13 the performance of the victim's official duties in the justice system:]
- "[(A) A police officer as defined in ORS 181A.355;]
- "[(B) A correctional, parole and probation officer or other person charged
- with the duty of custody, control or supervision of convicted persons;]
- "[(C) A member of the Oregon State Police;]
- "[(D) A judicial officer as defined in ORS 1.210;]
- "[(E) A juror or witness in a criminal proceeding;]
- 20 "[(F) An employee or officer of a court of justice;]
- "[(G) A member of the State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision;
- 22 *or*]
- "[(H) A regulatory specialist.]
- "[(b) The defendant was confined in a state, county or municipal penal or
- 25 correctional facility or was otherwise in custody when the murder occurred.]
- 26 "[(c) The defendant committed murder by means of an explosive as defined
- 27 in ORS 164.055.]
- "[(d) Notwithstanding ORS 163.115 (1)(b), the defendant personally and
- 29 intentionally committed the homicide under the circumstances set forth in ORS
- 30 *163.115* (1)(b).]

"[(e) The murder was committed in an effort to conceal the commission of a crime, or to conceal the identity of the perpetrator of a crime.] "[(f) The murder was committed after the defendant had escaped from a state, county or municipal penal or correctional facility and before the defendant had been returned to the custody of the facility.]".
