**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 1013**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 3, after “161.005,” insert “161.405,”.

2 On page 20, after line 5, insert:

3 **“SECTION 15a.** ORS 161.405 is amended to read:

4 “161.405. (1) A person is guilty of an attempt to commit a crime when the  
5 person intentionally engages in conduct which constitutes a substantial step  
6 toward commission of the crime.

7 “(2) An attempt is a:

8 “(a) Class A felony if the offense attempted is **any degree of murder,**  
9 **aggravated murder** or treason.

10 “(b) Class B felony if the offense attempted is a Class A felony.

11 “(c) Class C felony if the offense attempted is a Class B felony.

12 “(d) Class A misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class C felony or  
13 an unclassified felony.

14 “(e) Class B misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class A  
15 misdemeanor.

16 “(f) Class C misdemeanor if the offense attempted is a Class B  
17 misdemeanor.

18 “(g) Violation if the offense attempted is a Class C misdemeanor or an  
19 unclassified misdemeanor.”.

20 On page 31, line 28, after “161.005,” insert “161.405,”.
