**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2202**

1 Delete lines 4 through 7 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall develop**
3 **and administer a program to conduct outreach to residents of Oregon**
4 **who served in the Oregon National Guard or a reserve component of**
5 **the Armed Forces of the United States to:**

6 **“(a) Inform them about trade careers; and**

7 **“(b) Connect them with available apprenticeship opportunities.**

8 **“(2) The bureau may issue grants to trade unions and trade associ-**
9 **ations to be used to conduct outreach through job fairs or similar**
10 **recruitment methods.**

11 **“(3) The bureau may enter into one or more agreements with other**
12 **state agencies, including the Department of Veterans’ Affairs, the**
13 **Employment Department and the Department of Transportation, for**
14 **the purpose of identifying individuals for outreach purposes.**

15 **“(4) The bureau shall adopt rules to administer and implement the**
16 **provisions of this section.**

17 **“SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,**
18 **2019, from the Veterans’ Services Fund established under ORS 406.140,**
19 **to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, the amount of \$250,000 for the**
20 **purpose of implementing the provisions of section 1 of this 2019 Act.**

21 **“SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on Jan-**

1 uary 1, 2021.

2 **“SECTION 4. The Bureau of Labor and Industries may take any**
3 **action before the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act**
4 **that is necessary for the bureau to exercise, on and after the operative**
5 **date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act, all of the duties, functions**
6 **and powers conferred on the bureau by section 1 of this 2019 Act.”.**

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
