PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2202

- Delete lines 4 through 7 of the printed bill and insert:
- 2 "SECTION 1. (1) The Bureau of Labor and Industries shall develop
- and administer a program to conduct outreach to residents of Oregon
- 4 who served in the Oregon National Guard or a reserve component of
- 5 the Armed Forces of the United States to:
- 6 "(a) Inform them about trade careers; and
 - "(b) Connect them with available apprenticeship opportunities.
- 8 "(2) The bureau may issue grants to trade unions and trade associ-
- 9 ations to be used to conduct outreach through job fairs or similar
- 10 recruitment methods.

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- 11 "(3) The bureau may enter into one or more agreements with other
- 12 state agencies, including the Department of Veterans' Affairs, the
- 13 Employment Department and the Department of Transportation, for
- 14 the purpose of identifying individuals for outreach purposes.
- 15 "(4) The bureau shall adopt rules to administer and implement the
- 16 provisions of this section.
- "SECTION 2. There is allocated for the biennium beginning July 1,
- 2019, from the Veterans' Services Fund established under ORS 406.140,
- to the Bureau of Labor and Industries, the amount of \$250,000 for the
- 20 purpose of implementing the provisions of section 1 of this 2019 Act.
 - "SECTION 3. Section 1 of this 2019 Act becomes operative on Jan-

uary 1, 2021.

"SECTION 4. The Bureau of Labor and Industries may take any action before the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act that is necessary for the bureau to exercise, on and after the operative date specified in section 3 of this 2019 Act, all of the duties, functions and powers conferred on the bureau by section 1 of this 2019 Act.".
