PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2804

- On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "pets" insert a period and delete the rest of the line.
- Delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page 2 and insert:
- 4 "SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:
- 5 "(a) 'Assistance animal' and 'assistance animal trainee' have the 6 meanings given those terms in ORS 659A.143.
- "(b) 'Disability' means a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities of an individual.
- "(c) 'Major life activities' means activities or functions listed in ORS 659A.104 (2) or recognized in Bureau of Labor and Industries rules as major life activities.
- "(d) 'Pet' means an animal kept for purposes other than providing a person with a disability with trained assistance regarding the disability.
- "(e) 'Place of public accommodation' has the meaning given that term in ORS 659A.400.
- "(2) A person commits the offense of misrepresenting a pet as an assistance animal if the person:
- "(a) Brings a pet into a place of public accommodation and, in response to an inquiry by an owner or employee of the place of public accommodation, falsely asserts that the pet is an assistance animal

or assistance animal trainee; or

"(b)(A) Affixes to a pet any false information or improper identification vest, tag, license, permit or other device that portrays the pet as an assistance animal or assistance animal trainee; and

- "(B) Brings the pet into a place of public accommodation.
- "(3) Misrepresenting a pet as an assistance animal is a specific fine violation, subject to a fine not exceeding \$1,000.".
