**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
HOUSE BILL 2027**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 23, after “that” insert “the office, by  
2 rule, determines”.

3 On page 3, delete lines 40 and 41 and insert:

4 “(b) A criminal records check under this subsection must, if requested by  
5 the authorized agency, include a name-based check of the national sex  
6 offender registry maintained by the National Crime Information Center.”.

7 On page 7, line 15, delete “childcare” and insert “child care”.

8 On page 9, line 1, delete “childcare” and insert “child care”.

9 On page 10, delete lines 26 through 45.

10 On page 11, delete lines 1 through 8 and insert:

11 **“SECTION 8.** ORS 329A.505 is amended to read:

12 **“329A.505. (1) At any reasonable time, an authorized representative**  
13 **of** the Office of Child Care may [*visit and conduct on-site inspections of the*  
14 *premises of an exempt child care provider as defined by the Office of Child*  
15 *Care by rule whenever such inspections are required under federal law. The*  
16 *inspections may be conducted at any reasonable time and shall be limited to*  
17 *making a determination as to whether the requirements of applicable federal*  
18 *law have been met*] **conduct an inspection or investigation of a regulated**  
19 **subsidy facility, as defined by the Early Learning Council by rule.**

20 **“(2) When conducting an investigation under this section, the Office**  
21 **of Child Care may:**

1       **“(a) Take evidence;**

2       **“(b) Take the depositions of witnesses, including the person under**  
3 **investigation, in the manner prescribed by law for depositions in civil**  
4 **actions;**

5       **“(c) Compel the appearance of witnesses, including the person un-**  
6 **der investigation, in the manner prescribed by law for appearances in**  
7 **civil actions;**

8       **“(d) Require answers to interrogatories;**

9       **“(e) Compel the production of books, papers, accounts, documents**  
10 **or testimony that pertains to the matter under investigation;**

11       **“(f) Issue subpoenas; and**

12       **“(g) Inspect the premises of the facility under investigation.**

13       **“[(2)] (3) The Office of Child Care may, as a condition of finalizing [the]**  
14 **an inspection, require improvements, corrections or other measures to ensure**  
15 **that the [exempt child care provider] regulated subsidy facility complies**  
16 **with the requirements [of federal law for exempt child care providers] under**  
17 **the rules adopted under this section.**

18       **“(4) Notwithstanding ORS 329A.500 (1), the Early Learning Council,**  
19 **in consultation with the Department of Human Services, may adopt**  
20 **rules to establish minimum health and safety standards for regulated**  
21 **subsidy facilities and for the administration of this section.”.**

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
