**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
SENATE BILL 450**

1 On page 3 of the printed bill, delete lines 7 through 13 and insert:

2 “(c) If the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries has found
3 substantial evidence, under ORS 279C.306, that a contracting agency that
4 would otherwise receive increased amounts of fuel tax revenues pursuant to
5 this section on or after January 1, 2022, has violated ORS 279C.305 within
6 the five years immediately preceding the date of the commissioner’s finding,
7 or has materially breached an agreement entered into pursuant to ORS
8 279C.306, the Department of Transportation shall withhold the increased
9 amounts until the final resolution of the violation or breach is determined
10 under ORS 279C.306.”

11 On page 4, delete lines 5 through 11 and insert:

12 “(c) If the Commissioner of the Bureau of Labor and Industries has found
13 substantial evidence, under ORS 279C.306, that a contracting agency that
14 would otherwise receive increased amounts of fuel tax revenues pursuant to
15 this section on or after January 1, 2024, has violated ORS 279C.305 within
16 the five years immediately preceding the date of the commissioner’s finding,
17 or has materially breached an agreement entered into pursuant to ORS
18 279C.306, the Department of Transportation shall withhold the increased
19 amounts until the final resolution of the violation or breach is determined
20 under ORS 279C.306.”
