**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 2284**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, delete lines 4 through 28 and delete page
2 2 and insert:

3 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Port of Newport is renamed the Oregon**
4 **International Port of Newport.**

5 **“(2) ORS 777.135, 777.137, 777.155, 777.160 and 777.165 do not apply to**
6 **the port.**

7 **“(3) Except as provided in subsection (2) of this section, the port**
8 **has all the powers and duties of a port formed under ORS 777.010 and**
9 **777.050.**

10 **“SECTION 2. (1) The power and authority given to the Oregon**
11 **International Port of Newport is vested in and shall be exercised by a**
12 **board of five commissioners. The board may exercise such powers, at**
13 **regular or special meetings, as are usual and customary with similar**
14 **bodies.**

15 **“(2) Commissioners of the port shall be appointed by the Governor,**
16 **subject to Senate confirmation in the manner provided in ORS 171.562**
17 **and 171.565.**

18 **“(3) A person is eligible for appointment as a commissioner of the**
19 **port who at the time of the appointment is an elector registered in the**
20 **port, is a citizen of the United States and has for one year immediately**
21 **preceding appointment resided within the port.**

1 “(4) The term of office of a commissioner is two years, but each
2 commissioner serves at the pleasure of the Governor.

3 “(5) Before the expiration of the term of a commissioner, the Gov-
4 ernor shall appoint a successor. A commissioner is eligible for reap-
5 pointment. In case of a vacancy for any cause, the Governor shall
6 appoint a person to serve for the unexpired term. A commissioner
7 whose term has expired shall continue to serve until the appointment
8 of a successor unless discharged by the Governor.

9 “SECTION 3. Notwithstanding the term of office specified in section
10 2 (4) of this 2019 Act:

11 “(1) Commissioners who are serving on the board of the Oregon
12 International Port of Newport on the effective date of this 2019 Act
13 shall continue to serve until the expiration of their term, unless ear-
14 lier discharged by the Governor.

15 “(2) If the Governor discharges a commissioner who is serving on
16 the effective date of this 2019 Act before the expiration of that
17 commissioner’s term, the Governor shall appoint a replacement com-
18 missioner to serve for the remaining unexpired term of the discharged
19 commissioner.

20 “(3) Except for commissioners appointed to replace a discharged
21 commissioner under subsection (2) of this section, the first two com-
22 missioners appointed to the board of the Oregon International Port
23 of Newport by the Governor shall serve an initial term of one year. If
24 the Governor appoints more than two commissioners simultaneously,
25 the Governor shall specify which two of the commissioners are to
26 serve an initial one-year term.”.
