PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 3063

On page 6 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 12, insert:

"SECTION 12. (1) Prior to administering a vaccine to a patient, a health care practitioner shall record and maintain in the practitioner's records the health status of the patient prior to receiving the vaccine.

- "(2) After administering a vaccine to a patient, a health care practitioner shall:
- "(a) Submit a report to the national reporting system on adverse vaccine effects run by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention concerning any adverse events experienced by the patient following the administration of the vaccine for three years, whether or not the practitioner considers the adverse event to be related to the administration of the vaccine; and
- "(b) Record and maintain in the practitioner's records all adverse events experienced by the patient following the administration of the vaccine for three years, whether or not the practitioner considers the adverse event related to the administration of the vaccine.
- "(3) As used in this section, 'adverse event' means a possible side effect or a health problem.".
- In line 13, delete "12" and insert "13".
- In line 18, delete "13" and insert "14".

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
