- 2 "pharmacy bear a label in both English and in the language requested and,
- 3 if authorized by the board by rule, include an informational insert in both
- 4 English and the language requested. The rules adopted".
- 5 Delete lines 13 through 22.
- On page 2, delete lines 1 through 16 and insert:
- 7 "(b) Determine the pharmacies to which the requirements of this section
- 8 apply, and include at least retail drug outlets and other drug outlets that
- 9 dispense prescription drugs.
- "(c) Determine for which prescription drugs it is appropriate to include
 - an informational insert in addition to the label. In adopting rules under this
- 12 paragraph, the board shall consider the complexity and length of the di-
- 13 rections for use of the prescription drug.
- "(d)(A) Require that labels and informational inserts be available in at
- least 14 languages other than English that are spoken in Oregon by indi-
- viduals who are of limited English proficiency, as determined by the most
- 17 recent American Community Survey from the United States Census Bureau
- and in consultation with the Oregon Health Authority and other necessary
- 19 resources.
