**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
HOUSE BILL 3135**

1 Delete lines 5 through 16 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) For the purpose of enforcing the state transient**
3 **lodging tax, the Department of Revenue shall purchase access to raw**
4 **metadata scraped from the Internet that relates to the sale, service**
5 **or furnishing of transient lodging.**

6 **“(2)(a) The department shall implement an enhanced data-scraping**
7 **pilot program for the purpose of enforcing the state and local transient**
8 **lodging taxes.**

9 **“(b) The pilot program shall include at least two and not more than**
10 **four units of local government for which the department enforces the**
11 **local transient lodging tax pursuant to agreements entered into under**
12 **ORS 305.620.**

13 **“(c) The department shall prescribe the data that may be made**
14 **available to the units of local government.**

15 **“(3) Notwithstanding ORS 320.335, in order to fund the purchase**
16 **described in subsection (1) of this section and the pilot program de-**
17 **scribed in subsection (2) of this section, the department shall withhold**
18 **state transient lodging tax moneys that would otherwise be transferred**
19 **to the Oregon Tourism Commission under ORS 320.335 (2) until such**
20 **funding is complete.**

21 **“(4) As used in this section, ‘local transient lodging tax,’ ‘state**

1 **transient lodging tax’ and ‘unit of local government’ have the**
2 **meanings given those terms in ORS 320.300.**

3 **“SECTION 2. This 2019 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the**
4 **date on which the 2019 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative**
5 **Assembly adjourns sine die.”.**
