## PROPOSED MINORITY REPORT AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2014

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after "provisions;" insert "and".

2 In line 3, delete "; and declaring an emergency".

3 Delete lines 5 through 31.

4 On page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert:

5 **"SECTION 1.** ORS 31.710 is amended to read:

6 "31.710. (1) Except for claims subject to ORS 30.260 to 30.300 and ORS 7 chapter 656, in any civil action seeking damages arising out of bodily injury, 8 including emotional injury or distress, death or property damage of any one 9 person including claims for loss of care, comfort, companionship and society 10 and loss of consortium, the amount awarded for noneconomic damages shall 11 not exceed [\$500,000] **\$1.5 million**.

"(2) Beginning in 2020, and every year thereafter, the State Court 12 Administrator shall determine the percentage increase or decrease in 13 the cost of living for the previous calendar year, based on changes in 14 the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers, West Region (All 15 Items), as published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United 16 States Department of Labor. On or before July 1 of the year in which 17 the State Court Administrator makes the determination required by 18 this subsection, the State Court Administrator shall adjust the limi-19 tation imposed under subsection (1) of this section by multiplying the 20limitation amount applicable to the year in which the adjustment is 21

made by the percentage amount determined under this subsection. The State Court Administrator shall round the adjusted limitation amount to the nearest \$100, but the unrounded amount shall be used to calculate the adjustment to the limitation in the following year. The adjusted limitation becomes effective on July 1 of the year in which the adjustment is made, and applies to all causes of action arising on or after July 1 of that year and before July 1 of the following year.

8 "[(2) As used in this section:]

"[(a) 'Economic damages' means objectively verifiable monetary losses in-9 cluding but not limited to reasonable charges necessarily incurred for medical, 10 hospital, nursing and rehabilitative services and other health care services, 11 burial and memorial expenses, loss of income and past and future impairment 12of earning capacity, reasonable and necessary expenses incurred for substitute 13 domestic services, recurring loss to an estate, damage to reputation that is 14 economically verifiable, reasonable and necessarily incurred costs due to loss 15of use of property and reasonable costs incurred for repair or for replacement 16 of damaged property, whichever is less.] 17

"[(b) 'Noneconomic damages' means subjective, nonmonetary losses, including but not limited to pain, mental suffering, emotional distress, humiliation, injury to reputation, loss of care, comfort, companionship and society, loss of consortium, inconvenience and interference with normal and usual activities apart from gainful employment.]

23 "(3) This section does not apply to punitive damages.

"(4) The jury shall not be advised of the limitation set forth in this section.

"<u>SECTION 2.</u> The amendments to ORS 31.710 by section 1 of this
2019 Act apply to causes of action that arise on or after the effective
date of this 2019 Act.".
