

Requested by JOINT COMMITTEE ON WAYS AND MEANS

**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
SENATE BILL 28**

1 On page 1 of the printed bill, line 2, after the semicolon insert “creating  
2 new provisions;”.

3 In line 3, after “634.640” insert “; and declaring an emergency”.

4 On page 3, after line 16, insert:

5 **“SECTION 6. (1) The amendments to ORS 446.321 by section 1 of this**  
6 **2019 Act apply to Oregon Health Authority rules that establish tourist**  
7 **facility license fees for licensing periods that begin on or after July 1,**  
8 **2019.**

9 **“(2) The amendments to ORS 448.035, 448.037, 624.490 and 624.630 by**  
10 **sections 2 to 5 of this 2019 Act become operative on July 1, 2019.**

11 **“(3) If this 2019 Act becomes law after July 1, 2019:**

12 **“(a) No later than 30 days after the effective date of this 2019 Act,**  
13 **the Oregon Health Authority may adopt temporary rules under ORS**  
14 **446.321, establishing new tourist facility license fees to apply**  
15 **retroactively for tourist facility licensing periods beginning on or after**  
16 **July 1, 2019.**

17 **“(b) The Legislative Assembly intends that:**

18 **“(A) The amendments to ORS 448.035 by section 2 of this 2019 Act**  
19 **apply retroactively to fees paid for licensing periods beginning on or**  
20 **after July 1, 2019.**

21 **“(B) The amendments to ORS 448.037 by section 3 of this 2019 Act**

1 apply retroactively to applications received by the Oregon Health Au-  
2 thority on or after July 1, 2019.

3 “(C) The amendments to ORS 624.490 by section 4 of this 2019 Act  
4 apply retroactively to fees paid for licensing periods beginning on or  
5 after July 1, 2019.

6 “(D) The amendments to ORS 624.630 by section 5 of this 2019 Act  
7 apply retroactively to review services requested on or after July 1,  
8 2019.

9 “SECTION 7. This 2019 Act being necessary for the immediate  
10 preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is  
11 declared to exist, and this 2019 Act takes effect on its passage.”.
