7 “Improving People’s Access to Community-based Treatment, Supports and
8 Services”.

9 In line 15, after “tions” insert a semicolon and delete the rest of the line.

5 the subcommittee that contains personally identifiable information is exempt
6 from public disclosure under ORS 192.311 to 192.478. The subcommittee may
7 enter into agreements with appropriate agencies or other entities to share
8 data for specified purposes and with safeguards to restrict further
9 disclosure.”.

4 **“SECTION 9. The Improving People’s Access to Community-based**
5 **Treatment, Supports and Services Grant Review Committee estab-**
6 **lished in section 3 of this 2019 Act and the Oregon Health Authority**
7 **may work together to include coordinated care organizations in the**
8 **Improving People’s Access to Community-based Treatment, Supports**
9 **and Services Program, as permitted by state and federal law, in a way**
10 **that provides incentives for coordinated care organizations to provide**
11 **comprehensive community supports and services, as defined in section**
12 **6 of this 2019 Act, to their members who have mental health or sub-**
13 **stance use disorders and be appropriately reimbursed for the costs of**
14 **the supports and services.**

15 **“SECTION 10. The Improving People’s Access to Community-based**
16 **Treatment, Supports and Services Grant Review Committee shall ap-**
17 **point a subcommittee to explore policy areas for further discussion**
18 **during the 2020 regular session of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly.**
19 **The policy areas may include but need not be limited to diversion, laws**
20 **and other programs or projects intended to prevent the incarceration**
21 **of individuals with mental health or substance use disorders.”.**

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
