**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2020**

1 On page 20 of the printed A-engrossed bill, after line 43, insert:

2 “(3)(a) Subject to paragraphs (b) and (c) of this subsection, the office shall
3 retire from the annual allowance budget, on behalf of a covered entity that
4 is an electricity service supplier, allowances as follows:

5 “(A) Beginning in 2021 and for each following year until and including
6 2030, the office shall retire a number of allowances equal to 100 percent of
7 the verified anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions forecast to be regulated
8 emissions for which the electricity service supplier must meet a compliance
9 obligation; and

10 “(B) Beginning in 2031 and for each following year until and including
11 2050, the number of allowances retired by the office on behalf of a covered
12 entity that is an electricity service supplier shall decline annually from the
13 number of allowances retired on behalf of the electricity service supplier in
14 2030 by a constant amount, as necessary, so that for 2050 the number of al-
15 lowances retired is equal to 20 percent of the average of the annual emis-
16 sions of the electricity service supplier for the five most recent years prior
17 to the effective date of this 2019 Act, as reported under ORS 468A.280.

18 “(b) The number of allowances retired by the office on behalf of a covered
19 entity that is an electricity service supplier for a year may not exceed a
20 number of allowances equal to 100 percent of the electricity service
21 supplier’s regulated emissions for that year.

1 “(c) The office may request from each electricity service supplier infor-
2 mation that is reasonably necessary to enable the office to retire allowances
3 pursuant to this subsection, including information necessary to verify
4 anthropogenic greenhouse gas emissions forecast to be regulated emissions.
5 The office may not retire allowances pursuant to this subsection on behalf
6 of an electricity service supplier if the electricity service supplier fails to
7 submit to the office the information requested pursuant to this paragraph.”.

8 In line 44, delete “(3)” and insert “(4)”.

9 On page 37, after line 31, insert:

10 “(d) Any individually identifiable information, other than emissions data
11 submitted under ORS 468A.280, obtained by the office as necessary to ad-
12 minister and implement section 19 (3) of this 2019 Act.”.

13 On page 97, line 13, delete “(c)” and insert “(d)”.

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
