**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2020**

1 On page 96 of the printed A-engrossed bill, delete lines 16 through 27 and
2 insert:

3 **“SECTION 131. (1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other ap-**
4 **propriation, there is appropriated to the Oregon Department of Ad-**
5 **ministrative Services, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of**
6 **the General Fund, the amount of \$15,781,347, for carrying out the**
7 **provisions of chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill**
8 **2020).**

9 **“(2) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there**
10 **is appropriated to the State Forestry Department, for the biennium**
11 **beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount of**
12 **\$333,310, for carrying out the provisions of chapter _____, Oregon Laws**
13 **2019 (Enrolled House Bill 2020), related to the State Forestry Depart-**
14 **ment.**

15 **“(3) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there**
16 **is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department,**
17 **for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the**
18 **amount of \$568,654, for carrying out the provisions of chapter _____,**
19 **Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 2020), related to the Housing**
20 **and Community Services Department.**

21 **“(4) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the General Fund**

1 appropriation made to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission
2 by section 1 (1), chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill
3 5024), for the biennium beginning July 1, 2019, is increased by \$373,254,
4 for carrying out the provisions of chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019
5 (Enrolled House Bill 2020), related to the Higher Education Coordinat-
6 ing Commission.

7 “(5) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the
8 amount of \$250,000 is established for the biennium beginning July 1,
9 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from lottery
10 moneys allocated from the Administrative Services Economic Devel-
11 opment Fund to the Oregon Business Development Department to
12 conduct the analysis and develop the program proposal required by
13 section 130 of this 2019 Act.

14 “(6) Notwithstanding any other law limited expenditures, the limi-
15 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (1), chapter _____,
16 Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5017), for the biennium begin-
17 ning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from
18 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, the
19 proceeds of bonds for the Orphan Site Account and federal funds from
20 congestion mitigation and air quality grants, drinking water pro-
21 tection, beach bacteria monitoring, laboratory accreditation and
22 woodstove grants and for smoke monitoring laboratory services, but
23 excluding lottery funds and federal funds not described in section 2,
24 chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5017), collected
25 or received by the Department of Environmental Quality, for air
26 quality, is increased by \$1,039,640.

27 “(7) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
28 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (11), chapter _____,
29 Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5039), for the biennium begin-
30 ning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from

1 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and
2 federal funds received as reimbursement from the United States De-
3 partment of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal
4 funds not described in section 2, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019
5 (Enrolled House Bill 5039), collected or received by the Department of
6 Transportation, for transportation program development, is increased
7 by \$883,532.

8 “(8) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
9 tation on expenditures established by section 2 (15), chapter _____,
10 Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled House Bill 5039), for the biennium begin-
11 ning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from
12 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts and
13 federal funds received as reimbursement from the United States De-
14 partment of Transportation, but excluding lottery funds and federal
15 funds not described in section 2, chapter _____, Oregon Laws 2019
16 (Enrolled House Bill 5039), collected or received by the Department of
17 Transportation, for central services, is increased by \$1,207,439.

18 “(9) Notwithstanding any other law limiting expenditures, the limi-
19 tation on expenditures established by section 1 (1), chapter _____,
20 Oregon Laws 2019 (Enrolled Senate Bill 5534), for the biennium begin-
21 ning July 1, 2019, as the maximum limit for payment of expenses from
22 fees, moneys or other revenues, including Miscellaneous Receipts, but
23 excluding lottery funds and federal funds, collected or received by the
24 Public Utility Commission, for the utility program, is increased by
25 \$2,132,573.
