**PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO  
A-ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL 2206**

1 On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete the first semicolon  
2 and insert a period and delete the rest of the line.

3 Delete lines 6 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:

4 “(2) The State Resilience Officer shall study standards and procedures for  
5 determining whether buildings may be safely occupied after an emergency.  
6 Standards must align with national standards.

7 “(3) In conducting the study described in subsection (2) of this section,  
8 the State Resilience Officer shall consult with:

9 “(a) Local governments;

10 “(b) Relevant state agencies or offices, including the State Fire Marshal;  
11 and

12 “(c) Relevant professional organizations, including organizations repre-  
13 senting architects, engineers and building safety professionals.

14 **“SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-  
15 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of the Governor, for the  
16 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount  
17 of \$300,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1  
18 of this 2019 Act.”.**

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
