- On page 1 of the printed A-engrossed bill, line 2, delete the first semicolon
- 2 and insert a period and delete the rest of the line.
- Delete lines 6 through 22 and delete pages 2 and 3 and insert:
- 4 "(2) The State Resilience Officer shall study standards and procedures for
- 5 determining whether buildings may be safely occupied after an emergency.
- 6 Standards must align with national standards.
- 7 "(3) In conducting the study described in subsection (2) of this section,
- 8 the State Resilience Officer shall consult with:
- 9 "(a) Local governments;
- "(b) Relevant state agencies or offices, including the State Fire Marshal;
- 11 and
- "(c) Relevant professional organizations, including organizations repre-
- 13 senting architects, engineers and building safety professionals.
- "SECTION 2. In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropri-
- 15 ation, there is appropriated to the Office of the Governor, for the
- biennium beginning July 1, 2019, out of the General Fund, the amount
- of \$300,000 for the purpose of carrying out the provisions of section 1
- 18 of this 2019 Act.".
